

Shot Records/Requirements

We require a copy of your pet's current vaccination records.

Rabies Certificate

Not just a line showing that they had it and when it expires.
County is requiring an actual Rabies Certification for our file and here's what your veterinarian is required to provide you:

- Certificate of Vaccination—Information to Be Shown.

- A licensed veterinarian in the Department's jurisdiction who vaccinates a dog or cat against rabies must immediately issue a certificate of vaccination signed by the veterinarian to the owner or custodian of the dog or cat, and a duplicate certificate to the Director, stating:
- A. The name & address of the owner or custodian of the vaccinated dog or cat
 - B. The type of vaccine used, the name of the manufacturer, the manufacturer's serial or lot number, and the date of the vaccination.
 - C. The breed, age, color, and sex of the vaccinated dog or cat.

Your pet must have a **Distemper** and **Parvo** shot (DHPP, DHLPP, or DA2PP).

Your pet must have a **Bordetella** (kennel cough) vaccine done yearly and it must be current through their stay.

Updates must be done at least 24 hours prior to boarding.

- *Please note that due to many dogs frequenting groomers, pet stores, dog parks, etc., they are constantly exposed to the possibility of contracting kennel cough. The vaccine is similar to a flu shot in that it doesn't always prevent your dog from getting it, but helps them fight off the virus. We cannot guarantee that your dog will not get kennel cough when boarding as some dogs do not even show symptoms that may be carrying it while staying with us.*
